Just a quick update....for prayers.

Sister Raquel's mother died the night before I sent you my prayer request for them. She was 87 and died a model Christian death. We praise God for her life and testimony. Continue to pray for Sister Raquel as she grieves her loss. She returned to Chapulhuacanito a week and a half ago and is doing well.

Pray for the people of Frijolillo and the surrounding area. An 8 year old boy in our neighboring community of Zacapilo died last week of what they believe is dengue which is like malaria. We have had a few cases of fevers in Frijolillo this past week and health authorities are determining whether or not it is dengue. Pray that it is not, but if it is, that the Lord's protection would be upon us.

Pray too for our animals. There has been a number of cattle losses due to rabies.

I suffered three weeks of intense allergic reactions to all the trees in bloom this time of year. Fortunately I am finally coming out of it, but it was a rough few weeks. Pray that God would restore my immune system so I am not reacting so strongly to such benign offenders.

I took my final exam for my Gospel's class this past Tuesday and feel good about it. Also taught my first courses at the Bible Institute Wed and Thursday. Pray for me in these coming days as I write two papers as final requirements for the two courses I am completing. They need to be in the email on Thursday.....

Last night we had a successful showing of the Jesus film in Nahuatl in a community called Cojolapa where there are no Christian churches. After three years of ministry, a team of 5 brothers from the church in Huitzitzilingo finally have two families that have accepted Christ and a number of youth who are attending services and are interested in knowing more about Christ. Praise God with us for the opportunity to show the film and pray for the community. They have been very resistant to the Gospel, but little by little we are seeing fruit.
